This Award is presented to an individual or a team for their achievements in contributing to the Alberta life science cluster. This award celebrates the recipients success in creating opportunities that benefit the Alberta life sciences community and can include achievements by early stage/early career or established nominees.

Who is eligible?

Individuals or teams/organizations, including (without limitation) companies, non-profits, associations, agencies and consortia. Award nominees must be residents of Alberta, or have their primary base of operations in Alberta.

Who can submit a nomination?

Individuals, companies, associations, commercialization organizations, and government agencies may submit nominations.

Selection Criteria:

- The nominee's significant contributions to the success of the Alberta Life Science cluster.
 These contributions may take the form of technical innovation, business excellence, talent development, capital attraction, infrastructure development or other efforts where these achievements are not captured by other BioAlberta awards.
- The nominee's success in creating opportunities that benefit the broader Alberta life science community and can include achievements by early stage/early career nominees or established/late career nominees.
- We stress that individuals or teams/organizations are eligible for nomination.

Nomination Procedure:

Please complete the official Nomination Form (one form per nominee) and also include:

- Statement of Nomination (max. 750 words) which outlines how the nominee meets the award criteria.
 - The BioAlberta Awards Committee will pay special attention to the following elements of each nomination statement:
 - ➤ The nominees leadership role in creating sustained opportunities for others operating in the Alberta Life Science cluster, through their efforts including (without limitation) technical innovation, business excellence, talent development, capital attraction, infrastructure development or other efforts which have created compound success in Alberta
- Supporting documentation:
 - Previously published details of major achievements, other awards, media coverage, any analysis
 of the impact of the nominee's impact on the Alberta Life Sciences cluster. In the case of
