BIOJAPAN 2024

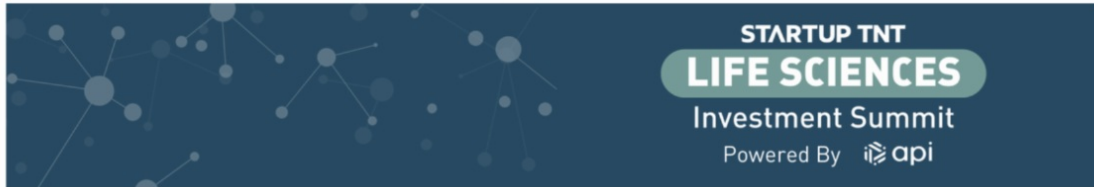
