BioTalent Canada Announces Research Project to Strengthen Inclusivity, Diversity, Equity, and Accessibility in Alberta's Bio-economy

BioTalent Canada has announced a new project, funded in part by the Province of Alberta and the Government of Canada, aimed at improving inclusivity, diversity, equity, and accessibility (IDEA) in Alberta's bio-economy.

Partnering with industry stakeholders, the project will conduct a labour market study to identify employment trends and barriers faced by equity-deserving groups, with the goal of developing resources to support companies in adopting IDEA best practices.
