Prairie Bioeconomy Guild: Innovate SynBioSpark

Join us on Wednesday, March 12, from 5:00 PM to 7:00 PM for BioAlberta's next Prairie BioEconomy Guild, at Brewsters Unity Square in Edmonton!

The evening will consist of networking and industry insights, featuring a presentation by Neethu Dax, Brittany Green, and Dr. Marina Lazic, from International Genetic Engineered Machines (iGEM) in Alberta.

This session will highlight the University of Alberta iGEM 2024 team's groundbreaking work on ReneWool, a novel synthetic biology approach to tackling textile waste. The project upcycles blended textile waste into spider silk using enzymatic breakdown, providing a sustainable alternative to conventional recycling

methods. This innovative solution not only addresses the environmental impact of fast fashion but also advances the circular economy by repurposing waste materials for high-value applications such as tissue scaffolding and drug delivery. The team's efforts earned them a gold medal at the iGEM 2024 Grand Jamboree in Paris, showcasing Alberta's leadership in synthetic biology.
