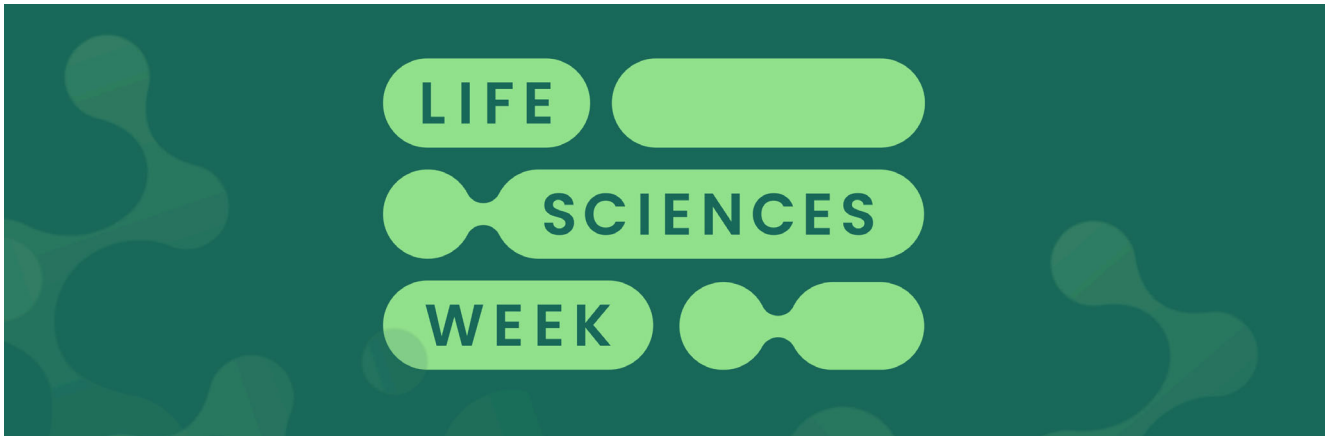

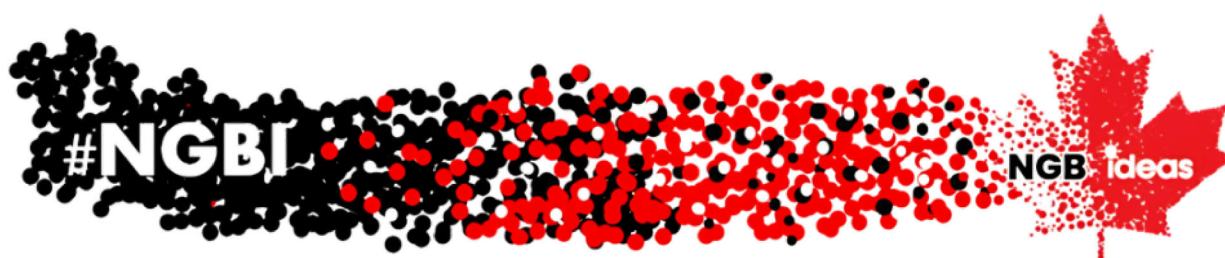
Reduced Rates for BIOSPAIN for Canadian Participants
